<p>Use different color paints (water, finger, etc.) to mix colors and create different colors.</p>	<p>Go outside, lie on a blanket, talk about the clouds, sun, and sky. Draw pictures of what you see.</p>	<p>Do online research about a favorite animal. Talk about life cycle, eating habits, environment.</p>
<p>Read a favorite story book. Ask your child to identify the “star” (main character), the setting, the problem, and the solution in the story.</p>	<p>Perform a sink or float experiment. Fill a plastic container or the sink with water. Select different objects to put in the water to see if they sink or float. Talk about the weight/density of the objects. Have your child predict if they will sink or float.</p>	<p>Log onto BrainPOP Jr. Watch the video: “Reduce, Reuse, Recycle”. Have your student find items in your household that can be recycled and reused. Talk about ways to reduce waste (water, energy, etc.). Username: medlockbridge Password: brainpop</p>
<p>Place flat objects on a dark sheet of construction paper (like a ruler or key). Place in direct sunlight for a few hours. Show how the sunlight faded the paper, leaving dark silhouettes. Talk about cause and effect.</p>	<p>Log onto ABCYA.com and click on Grade K. Have your student choose a numbers or letters activity to work on for 15 minutes.</p>	<p>Use cereal (like Fruit Loops) or candy (M&M’s, Skittles) or different colored pasta and have your child sort them by color. Then have your child count each color, talk about what color has the most, what color has the least.</p>
